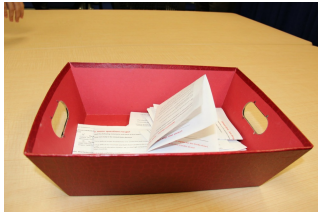


SEEKING CAL-NEVA OFFICER NOMINATIONS
